



This course provides the foundation for customizing the appearance of DM Webtop. On completion of this course, participants will build hands-on experience by customizing an out-of-the box DM Webtop. This includes using JavaScript/HTML to modify various ASP files in order to add a new tab, add a button, add an action, and customize the appearance of a form. Participants are expected to be knowledgeable in ASP, COM/DCOM, JavaScript, HTML, and object-oriented concepts. To best understand how to customize the DM Webtop, it is essential that you have a solid grasp of DM Webtop from both a user and administrative perspective. This course does not cover topics for using the DM API or DM Extensions API for building customized document management system functions.

**Course Objectives:**

On completion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Describe the DM Webtop Interface architecture to understand how to implement customizations in DM Webtop
- Describe and use various constructs from the DM Webtop Interface to provide the following types of customizations:
  - Appearance customizations that include changing displayed strings, colors, and images.
  - Flow customizations which include adding/removing actions, tabs, toolbar buttons, and nodes within the navigation tree
  - Form customizations which include how adding new fields to HTML-based forms, and how to customize the appearance of forms in DM Webtop

**Prerequisites:**

- Students must be comfortable using the DM Webtop client and must have DM administration experience
- Web programming experience in ASP/HTML/JavaScript (DM Webtop customizations are performed using these languages), as well as familiarity with object-oriented programming and COM/DCOM concepts, is required
